### RECRUITING DASHBOARD OVERVIEW

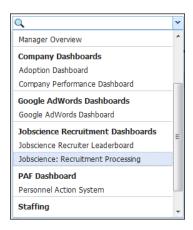
Accessing Jobscience Recruiting Dashboards

All of the Recruiting Dashboards reside under the **Dashboards** tab within Salesforce. You can access the **Dashboards** tab in one of two ways:

- Visible: **Dashboards** is a common tab and can be visible by default in some applications. If you see it at the top of the screen, click the **Dashboards** tab to be taken to that screen.
- Hidden: If you do not see the **Dashboards** tab, click on the + icon located at the end of the tab bar. This icon brings
  you to the **All Tabs** screen. Select **Dashboards** from the list to be taken to the **Dashboards** screen.

#### To access the Recruitment Dashboards

- 1. Within the **Dashboards** tab, select the **View Dashboard** drop-down.
- 2. Scroll to the section labeled Recruitment Dashboards.



#### Jobscience: Recruiter Leaderboard

This dashboard is designed to give a snapshot of recruiters within your company.

Title	Layout	Description
Leaderboard	Table	Counts the status of each job order by recruiter.



Applicant Flow by Recruiter	Table	Counts the amount of applicants by recruiter.
Search Wall of Fame	Table	Counts the number of searches by users in the system.
Recruiter KPIs	Table	Counts the number of Key Performance Indicators (KPI) <sup>1</sup> each recruiter achieved last month.
Most Active Staff	Table	Counts the activity of users in the system.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> KPI Count is a formula that sums the number of items in each stage of the Job Order. This formula is an additional field that must be added to the Job Order page layout to display on the report. For more details, see **Adding a Field into a Page Layout** within the **Configuring Jobscience Recruiting Dashboards** on page 5.

#### **Jobscience: Recruitment Processing**

This dashboard is designed to give a snapshot of recruitment as it relates to time and sources.

Title	Layout	Description
Pipeline	Funnel	The pipeline shows all Job Orders in the system and in which overall stage they reside.
Sources	Pie	This chart shows the strength of applicant sources amongst all the candidates in the system.
Job: Average Days Open	Gauge	This chart shows the average number of days a Job Order is open from the post date.
Pipeline	Stacked Horizontal Bar Chart	This chart shows by recruiter in which stages their Job Orders reside.
Source by Job	Stacked Vertical Bar Chart	This chart shows by Job Order which sources are most popular.
Total Searches Run	Gauge	This gauge counts how many searches were completed in the system over all time.
Search Type	Table	This table counts the amount of searches grouped by type.

## Configuring Jobscience Recruiting Dashboards

Most of the reports in **Jobscience Recruiting Dashboards** run with fields that are already contained within objects installed through **Jobscience Recruiting**; however, some fields must be added to their objects in order to be visible and reportable.

#### Adding a Field into a Page Layout

In this example, a field is added to the Job Order object. This example can be repeated for all Objects within the system.

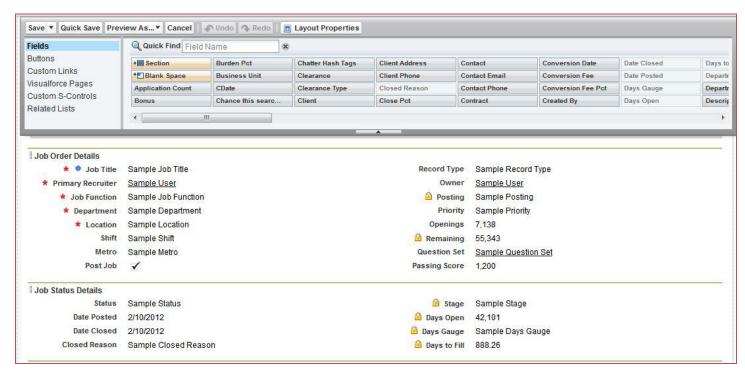

#### To add a field to a page layout

- Click Setup / Create / Objects / Job Order.
- Click Edit next to the desired Page Layout.
- Use the floating box on the top to find the field you would like to add to the page layout. If it has already been added to
  the page, it will be unselectable. If it is selectable, click the field and drag it into the layout at the desired location on
  the page.



Click the Save button to save the current view.
